Animal Science

On December 19th and 20th the Fremont High School Animal Science program conducted a lab at the Weber School District Agricultural Education Facility in Taylor, Utah. During this Lab students: ultra-sounded ewes bred approximately 100 days prior, to determine pregnancy, balanced a ration based on crude protein content using a Pearson square, and preformed a health checked pregnant ewes. This was an opportunity for students to receive practical experience on standards they have learned so far this year.
