Annual Weber State Design Build Conference

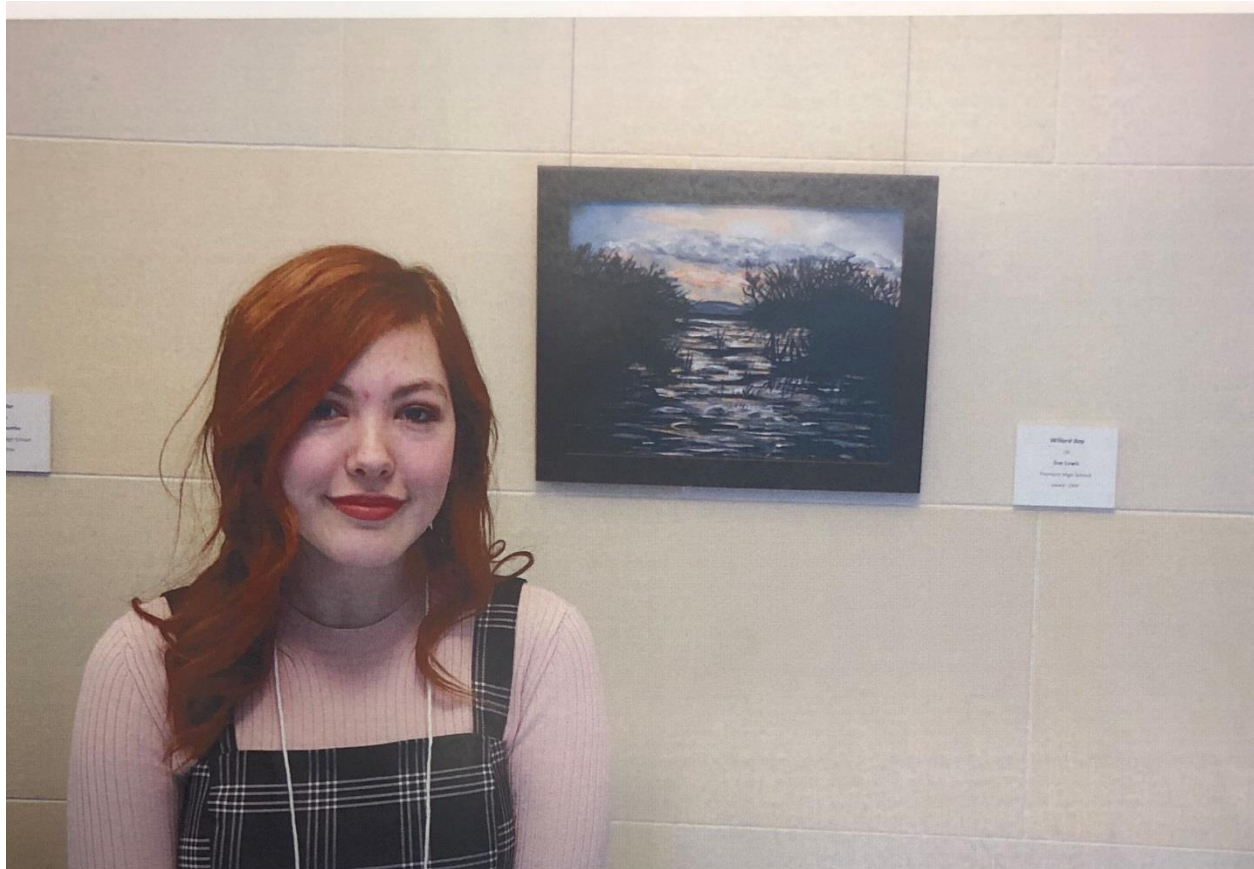
